In 2019, when Alpine Air planned to grow its fleet of cargo aircraft, owner Chuck Dubell anticipated increasing staff too. The newly acquired aircraft would require improvements before joining the active fleet. In addition to mechanics, Alpine Air needed more pilots and flight followers to support the growing fleet.

Chuck contacted the SBDC and Big Sky Economic Development Authority to learn more about the Big Sky Trust Fund Job Creation Grant. When COVID-19 posed challenges to the process, Regional Director Lorene Hintz and other BSEDA staff helped by requesting extensions. Alpine Air received \$125,000 in grant funding and matched it with \$125,000. This \$250,000 impact created 25 highpaying jobs in Montana. Over the past three years, Chuck has continued expanding recruiting efforts and hiring staff at all Alpine Air locations.

"Working with Alpine Air was a great experience. They were very responsive to every request to complete the Big Sky Trust Fund application and fill out the quarterly reports," stated Lorene Hintz.
